Bouldering Unlike free solo climbing, which is also performed without ropes, bouldering problems (the sequence of moves that a climber performs to complete the climb) are usually less than six metres (20 ft) tall. Height, arm length, flexibility, and other body characteristics can also affect difficulty. Bouldering is a form of rock climbing that is performed on small rock formations or artificial rock walls without the use of ropes or harnesses. Traverses, which are a form of boulder problem, require the climber to climb horizontally from one end to another. Bouldering competitions take place in both indoor and outdoor settings, that affects how difficult a problem may be for a particular climber. Artificial climbing walls allow boulderers to climb indoors in areas without natural boulders. While bouldering can be done without any equipment, most climbers use climbing shoes to help secure footholds, chalk to keep their hands dry and to provide a firmer grip, and bouldering mats to prevent injuries from falls.

In their design, what differentiates the five types (and their subtypes) is how unstable each of them is, i.e., in how many and in which of the three dimensions of space each board turns and/or sways and how freely its fulcrum contacts the board and the ground.
