The websites are written, according to the Times's investigation, by a network of authors in Macedonia, previously known for publishing disinformation during the 2016 US presidential election. Voting Systems and Smartmatic, alleging the network's hosts and guests knowingly promoted falsehoods that their voting machines were rigged to prevent Donald Trump's reelection in the 2020 presidential election. The companies sought a total of \$4.3 billion in damages.
