It is soluble in water, ethanol, and acetone. As determined by neutron diffraction, the uranyl center is characteristically linear with short $\text{U}=\text{O}$ distances. In the equatorial plane of the complex are six $\text{U}-\text{O}$ bonds to bidentate nitrate and two water ligands. At 245 pm, these $\text{U}-\text{O}$ bonds are much longer than the $\text{U}=\text{O}$ bonds of the uranyl center. 27380cabf9 Silver nitrate is the least expensive salt of silver; it offers several other advantages as well. It is non-hygroscopic (in contrast to silver fluoroborate and silver perchlorate). In addition, it is relatively stable to light, and it dissolves in numerous solvents, including water.
