Dry cleaning friction from tumbling effectively removes stains. Garments Dry cleaning is any cleaning process for clothing and textiles using a solvent other than water. A dry cleaning machine is similar to a combination of a domestic washing machine and clothes dryer. Clothes are instead soaked in a water-free liquid organic solvent (usually non-polar, as opposed to water which is a polar solvent) typically inside a specialised dry-cleaning machine. Historical solvents include gasoline, kerosene, Stoddard solvent, carbon tetrachloride, trichloroethylene, trichlorotrifluoroethane, trichloroethane and n-propyl bromide. The most commonly used solvent is perchloroethylene (known as "PCE" or "perc" for short), although other solvents such as hydrocarbon mixtures and decamethylcyclopentasiloxane are also used

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Conservation and restoration of textiles The concept of textile preservation applies to a wide range of artifacts, including tapestries, carpets, quilts, clothing, flags and curtains, as well as objects which "contain" textiles, such as upholstered furniture, dolls, and accessories such as fans, parasols, gloves and hats or bonnets. A wide range of speciality detergents are available from conservation suppliers The conservation and restoration of textiles refers to the processes by which textiles are cared for and maintained to be preserved from future damage. chemicals used in most clothes detergents are too harsh for old fibres to withstand.
