Croup interferes with normal breathing and produces the classic symptoms of "barking/brassy" cough, inspiratory stridor, and a hoarse voice. Fever and runny nose

Hantavirus hemorrhagic fever with renal syndrome Symptoms usually occur 2 weeks after exposure. Hantavirus hemorrhagic fever with renal syndrome (HFRS) is a hemorrhagic fever caused by hantavirus infection

Typhoid fever This is commonly. Often there is a gradual onset of a high fever over several days. from mild to severe, and usually begin six to 30 days after exposure

There is no vaccine for scarlet fever. Prevention is by frequent handwashing, not sharing personal items, and staying away from other people when sick. The disease is treatable with antibiotics, which reduce symptoms...

Occult pneumonia The general symptoms cough for more than 10 days and fever for more than 3 days can indicate the presence of occult pneumonia. visible by chest X-rays

Paratyphoid fever Typhoid and paratyphoid are of similar severity. Paratyphoid and typhoid fever are types of enteric fever. Without treatment, symptoms may last weeks or months. Often, a gradual onset of a high fever occurs over several days. Symptoms usually begin 6–30 days after exposure and are the same as those of typhoid fever. Weakness, Paratyphoid fever, also known simply as paratyphoid, is a bacterial infection caused by one of three types of *Salmonella enterica*. Some people develop a skin rash with rose-colored spots. begin 6–30 days after exposure and are the same as those of typhoid fever. Other people may carry the bacteria without being affected; however, they are still able to spread the disease to others. Often, a gradual onset of a high fever occurs over several days. Weakness, loss of appetite, and headaches also commonly occur a88b647bd9

Paratyphoid is caused by the bacterium *Salmonella enterica* of the serotypes Paratyphi A, Paratyphi B, or Paratyphi C growing in the intestines and blood. They are usually spread by eating or drinking food or water contaminated with the feces of an infected person. They may occur when a person who prepares food is infected. Risk factors include poor sanitation as is found among poor crowded populations. Occasionally, they may be transmitted by sex. Humans are the only animals infected. Diagnosis may be based... a88b647bd9

Scarlet fever It most commonly affects children and young adolescents between five and 15 years of age. On darker-pigmented skin the rash may be hard to discern. The rash occurs as a result of capillary damage by exotoxins produced by *S.* The bacteria are usually spread by people coughing Scarlet fever, also known as scarlatina and scarlatiniform rash, is an infectious disease caused by *Streptococcus pyogenes*,

a Group A streptococcus (GAS). It typically feels like sandpaper and the tongue may be red and bumpy. pyogenes. fever develops in a small number of people who have strep throat or streptococcal skin infections. The signs and symptoms include a sore throat, fever, headache, swollen lymph nodes, and a characteristic rash. The face is flushed and the rash is red and blanching a88b647bd9

Scarlet fever develops in a small number of people who have strep throat or streptococcal skin infections. The bacteria are usually spread by people coughing or sneezing. It can also be spread when a person touches an object that has the bacteria on it and then touches their mouth or nose. The diagnosis is typically confirmed by culturing swabs of the throat. a88b647bd9

Bronchitis Chronic bronchitis is defined as a productive cough – one that produces sputum – that lasts for three months or more per year for at. help with the fever a88b647bd9
