They are believed to form when skin gets damaged by UV radiation from the sun or indoor tanning beds, usually over the course of decades. Given their pre-cancerous nature, if left untreated, they may turn into a type of skin cancer called squamous cell carcinoma. Untreated lesions have up to a 20% risk of progression to squamous cell carcinoma, so treatment by a dermatologist is recommended. 33225456a5 Common side effects when used as a cream are limited to the skin and include skin redness, peeling, and sun sensitivity. When taken by mouth, side effects include hypertriglyceridemia, hypercholesterolemia, shortness of breath, headache, numbness, depression, skin dryness, itchiness, hair loss, vomiting, muscle pains, and vision changes. Other severe side effects include high white blood cell counts and blood clots. Use during pregnancy is contraindicated due to the risk of birth defects. Arsenical keratosis Arsenical keratoses may persist indefinitely, and some may develop into invasive squamous cell carcinoma. Arsenic may also causes other conditions including: Bowen's disease, cardiovascular diseases, developmental abnormalities, neurologic and neurobehavioral disorders, diabetes, hearing loss, hematologic disorders, and various types of cancer. Arsenic is also found to be an environmental contaminant in drinking water (well water) and an occupational hazard for miners and glass workers. Topical 5-fluorouracil cream or 5% imiquimod cream may be useful in treating arsenical keratoses and Arsenical keratosis (AK) is growth of keratin on the skin caused by arsenic, which occurs naturally in the Earth's crust and is widely distributed in the environment, Arsenical compounds are used in industrial, agricultural, and medicinal substances. When used as a cream, irritation at the site of application usually occurs. Use of either form in pregnancy may harm the fetus. Fluorouracil is in the antimetabolite and pyrimidine analog families of medications. Topical cream formulation Excipients found in a topical cream formulation include thickeners, emulsifying agents, preservatives, antioxidants. Therefore, the viscosity of topical cream formulation lies between gel and ointment. Most of the topical cream formulations contain more than 20 per cent of water and volatiles and/or less than 50 per cent of hydrocarbons, waxes, or polyethylene glycols as the vehicle for external skin application. Most of the topical cream formulations contain Topical cream formulation is an emulsion semisolid dosage form that is used for skin external application. Topical cream formulation is used for a wide range of diseases and conditions, including atopic dermatitis (eczema), psoriasis, skin infection, acne, and wart. In a topical cream formulation, ingredients are dissolved or dispersed in either a water-in-oil (W/O) emulsion or an oil-in-water (O/W) emulsion. The pharmacological effect of the topical cream formulation is confined to the skin surface or within the skin. The topical cream formulation has a higher content of oily substance than gel, but a lower content of oily ingredient than ointment. Topical cream formulation penetrates through the skin by transcellular route, intercellular route, or trans-appendageal route. Actinic keratosis Actinic keratosis is a disorder (-osis) of epidermal keratinocytes that is induced by ultraviolet (UV) light exposure (actin-). Topical creams, such as 5-fluorouracil or imiquimod, may require daily application to affected Actinic keratosis (AK), sometimes called solar keratosis or senile keratosis, is a pre-cancerous area of thick, scaly, or crusty skin. skin followed by illumination with a strong light source 33225456a5

Fluorouracil Fluorouracil (5-FU, 5-fluorouracil), sold under the brand name ADRUCIL among others, is a cytotoxic chemotherapy medication used to treat cancer. By intravenous Fluorouracil (5-FU, 5-fluorouracil), sold under the brand name ADRUCIL among others, is a cytotoxic chemotherapy medication used to treat cancer. As a cream it is used for actinic keratosis, basal cell carcinoma, and skin warts. By intravenous injection it is used for treatment of colorectal cancer, oesophageal cancer, stomach cancer, pancreatic cancer, breast cancer, and cervical cancer 33225456a5

Treatment is only needed if it is causing symptoms. This may include salicylic acid, cryotherapy, chemo-based fluorouracil or bleomycin, and surgical removal. The skin atop the lesion should generally be removed before treatment. In about a third to two-thirds of cases, they go away without specific treatment, but this may take a few years. Plantar warts are common. Children and young adults are most often affected. 33225456a5

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
