Its occurrence is also associated with certain disease processes, such as Kawasaki disease and genitourinary tuberculosis. Nephrology The word "renal" is an adjective meaning "relating to the kidneys", and its roots are French or late Latin. (hematuria), protein in the urine (proteinuria), pus cells in the urine (pyuria) or cancer cells in the urine. A 24-hour urine collection used to be Nephrology (from Ancient Greek νεφρός (nephros), meaning "kidney", and λόγος (logos), meaning "study") is a specialty for both adult internal medicine and pediatric medicine that concerns the study of the kidneys, specifically normal kidney function (renal physiology) and kidney disease (renal

pathophysiology), the preservation of kidney health, and the treatment of kidney disease, from diet and medication to renal replacement therapy (dialysis and kidney transplantation). Some experts believe "renal" and "nephro-" should be replaced with "kidney" in scientific writings such as "kidney medicine" (instead of "nephrology") or "kidney replacement therapy". Nephrostomy It is an interventional radiology/surgical procedure in which the renal pelvis is punctured whilst using imaging as guidance. The catheter is inserted through the guidewire A nephrostomy or percutaneous nephrostomy is an artificial opening created between the kidney and the skin which allows for the urinary diversion directly from the upper part of the urinary system (renal pelvis). A nephrostomy tube may then be placed to allow drainage.
