== Signs and symptoms == The ISU published the preliminary assignments on May 26, 2017. The shoulder joint is composed of three bones: the clavicle (collarbone), the scapula (shoulder blade), and the humerus (upper arm bone) (see diagram). Two joints facilitate shoulder movement. The acromioclavicular (AC) joint is located between the acromion (part of the scapula that forms the highest point of the shoulder) and the clavicle. The glenohumeral joint, to which the term "shoulder joint" commonly refers, is a ball-and-socket joint that allows... It is most often caused by a fall directly onto a shoulder, direct trauma to the bone, or a fall onto an outstretched arm. The fracture can also occur in a baby during childbirth. Rare causes of clavicle fractures include muscle contractions during seizures and minimal trauma in the setting of pathologic bone conditions. The middle section of the clavicle is most often involved. Diagnosis is typically based on symptoms and trauma then confirmed with X-rays.
