Another type, acute beriberi, found mostly in babies, presents with loss of appetite, vomiting, lactic acidosis, changes in heart rate, and enlargement of the heart. The name beriberi was possibly borrowed in the 18th century from the Sinhalese phrase බරිබරි බරිබරි (bæri bæri, "I cannot, I cannot"), owing to the weakness caused by the condition.
