Renal is Latin for "kidney", while nephro is the Greek equivalent. Lithiasis (Greek) and calculus (Latin; plural calculi) both mean stone. Hence, kidney stones are sometimes known as renal calculi or nephroliths, and the condition may be known as nephrolithiasis. 08026dc719 THP is a GPI-anchored glycoprotein. It is not derived from blood plasma but is produced by the thick ascending limb of the loop of Henle of the mammalian kidney. While the monomeric molecule has a MW of approximately 85 kDa, it is physiologically present in urine in large aggregates of up to several million Da. When this protein is concentrated at low pH, it forms a gel. Uromodulin represents the most abundant protein in normal human urine (results based on MSMS determinations). It is the matrix of urinary casts derived from the secretion of renal tubular cells. 08026dc719 Symptoms of hydronephrosis differ among individuals depending on how quickly urine flow is blocked and whether the blockage is slowly or suddenly. Sudden obstruction in the outflow of urine may lead to severe flank pain, while an obstruction that forms slowly may cause little or no pain. Studies show... 08026dc719 Maternal hypertensive disorders occurred in about 20.7 million women in 2013. About 10% of pregnancies globally are complicated by hypertensive diseases. In the United States, hypertensive disease of pregnancy affects about 8% to 13% of pregnancies. Rates have increased in the developing world. They resulted in 29,000 deaths in 2013, down from 37,000 deaths in 1990. They are one of the three major causes of death in pregnancy (16%) along with post partum bleeding (13%) and puerperal infections (2%). 08026dc719

Hydronephrosis Hydronephrosis can affect one or both kidneys and can develop suddenly or gradually over time. often caused by a structural abnormality while in adults, hydronephrosis is commonly caused by kidney stones, prostate enlargement, or cancer. Symptoms Hydronephrosis is a medical condition where the kidney becomes enlarged due to a complete or partial obstruction in the outflow of urine. This results in the dilation of parts of the kidney that function to collect urine (renal pelvis and calyces). This condition affects individuals of all ages including in fetuses during pregnancy 08026dc719

The most common cause of infection is E. coli, though other bacteria or fungi may sometimes be the cause. Risk factors include being female, sexual intercourse, diabetes, using a catheter, and family history. Additional factors that have been found to increase the risk of infection include urinary retention (delaying urination), insufficient water intake, use of spermicides as a contraceptive method, and poor genital hygiene. 08026dc719

Kidney stone disease About half of all people who have had a kidney stone are likely to develop another within ten years. Because renal calculi typically form in the kidney, if small enough they may pass out of the urinary tract through the urine stream. 2 inches), it can cause blockage of the ureter, resulting in extremely sharp and severe pain (renal colic) in the lower back that often radiates to the groin. A small calculus may pass without causing any symptoms. A calculus may also result in blood in the urine, vomiting (owing to severe pain), swelling of the kidney, or painful urination. This imbalance causes tiny crystals to aggregate and form hard masses, or calculi (stones), in the upper urinary tract.
