NCAA banned substances In 1999, NCAA Drug Committee published a list containing substances banned for the usage to student-athletes. Side effects of alcohol and beta blockers include high blood pressure, dizziness, nausea, diarrhea, constipation, slow heartbeat In the United States the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), has since the 1970s been patrolling the usage of illegal drugs and substances for student-athletes attending universities and colleges. If any student is caught taking any of the substances, they are subjected to suspension or even banned from participating in NCAA sports and possibly attending the university. It is common for those who suffer from emetophobia to be underweight or malnourished due to strict diets and restrictions they make for themselves. The thought of someone possibly vomiting can cause the phobic person to engage in

Beverage-specific effects of additives or by-products such as congeners in alcoholic beverages also play an important role. Antiemetics are sometimes necessary to suppress nausea and vomiting. While hand washing with soap and water is generally preferred, hand sanitizer is a convenient alternative in settings where soap and water are unavailable. sanitizers do not eliminate all types of germs. Improper use, such as wiping off sanitizer before it dries, can also reduce its effectiveness, and some sanitizers with low alcohol concentrations are less effective. However, it is less effective against certain pathogens like norovirus and *Clostridioides difficile* and cannot physically remove harmful chemicals. It can also come in the form of a cream, spray, or wipe. Conditioned taste aversion can occur when sickness is merely coincidental to, and not caused by, the substance consumed. For example, a person who becomes very sick after consuming tequila-and-orange-juice cocktails may then become averse to the taste of orange juice, even though the sickness was caused by the over-consumption of alcohol.
