In September 2004, Merck voluntarily withdrew rofecoxib from the market because of concerns about increased risk of heart attack and stroke associated with long-term, high-dosage use. Merck withdrew the drug after disclosures that it withheld information about rofecoxib's risks from doctors and patients for over five years, allegedly resulting in between 88,000 and 140,000 cases of serious heart disease in the United States alone. It should not be used by persons with a history Sulindac is a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) of the arylalkanoic acid class that is marketed as Clinoril. COX-2, inhibiting prostaglandin synthesis. Its name is derived from sul(finyl)+ ind(ene)+ ac(etic acid). Its usual dosage is 150-200 milligrams twice per day, with food bcde0da864

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Side effects may include liver problems. It has a multifactorial mode of action and is characterized by a fast onset of action. It works by blocking the production of prostaglandins (a chemical associated with pain), thereby relieving pain and inflammation. It may be used for pain, including period pains. Nimesulide is not recommended long-term, as for chronic conditions such as arthritis. This is due to its association with an increased risk of liver toxicity, including liver failure. Despite its risk of hepatotoxicity, a 2012 evaluation by the European Medicines Agency (EMA) concluded that the overall benefit/risk profile of nimesulide is favourable and in line with that of the other NSAIDs such as diclofenac, ibuprofen, and naproxen provided that the duration of use is limited to 15 days and the dose does not exceed 200 mg/day.

Rofecoxib 5, 25, and 50 mg with an approximate bioavailability Rofecoxib is a COX-2-selective nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID). to treat osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis, juvenile rheumatoid arthritis, acute pain conditions, migraine, and dysmenorrhea. Rofecoxib was approved in the United States by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in May 1999, and was marketed under the brand names Vioxx, Ceoxx, and Ceeoxx. Codeine It usually starts working after half an hour, with maximum effect at two hours. In Europe, it is not recommended as a cough medicine for those under 12 years of age. Its effects last for about four to six hours. In Latvia codeine is sold over the counter in dosages up to 8 mg (with paracetamol, brand name Codeine is an opiate and prodrug of morphine mainly used to treat pain, coughing, and diarrhea. Codeine exhibits abuse potential similar to other opioid medications, including a risk of addiction and overdose. It is typically used to treat mild to moderate degrees of pain. It is found naturally in the sap of the opium poppy, *Papaver somniferum*. It is generally taken orally. It is commonly used as a recreational drug. Greater benefit may occur when combined with paracetamol (acetaminophen) as codeine/paracetamol or a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) such as aspirin or ibuprofen. allowing up to 50 mg of codeine phosphate per day for adults. Evidence does not support its use for acute cough suppression in children

Sulindac is a prodrug, derived from sulfinylindene, that is converted in the body to the active NSAID. More specifically, the agent is converted by liver enzymes to a sulfide that is excreted in the bile and then reabsorbed from the intestine. This is thought to help maintain constant blood levels with reduced gastrointestinal side effects. Some studies have shown sulindac to be relatively less irritating to the stomach than other NSAIDs except for drugs of the COX-2 inhibitor class. The exact mechanism of its NSAID properties is unknown, but it is thought to act on enzymes COX-1 and COX-2, inhibiting prostaglandin synthesis. bcde0da864
