The development process of the COVID Tracker app began on 22 March 2020 when the Health Service Executive (HSE) contracted a contact tracing app for Ireland to be built, using existing Bluetooth technology in smartphones to support contact tracing. The €850,000 project involved representatives from the Department of Health, the Economic and Social Research Institute (ESRI), the Garda Síochána, the Irish Army and Science Foundation Ireland.
