Nail polish originated in China and dates back to 3000 BCE. Around 600 BCE, during the Zhou dynasty, the royal house preferred the colors gold and silver. However, red and black eventually replaced these metallic colors as royal favorites. During the Ming dynasty, nail polish was often made from a mixture that included beeswax, egg whites, gelatin, vegetable dyes, and gum arabic. Trachyonychia causes the nails to become opalescent, thin, dull, fragile, and finely longitudinally ridged, and, as a result, distally notched. It can be a manifestation of lichen planus, psoriasis, alopecia areata, immunoglobulin A deficiency, atopic dermatitis, and ichthyosis vulgaris. == Geography == Most people with yellow nail syndrome (four fifths) have lymphedema; it is symmetrical and typically affects both legs. It is the first symptom of the condition in about a third. Involvement of the arms and face is more unusual, as is lymphedema of the abdomen with ascites (fluid collection in the abdominal cavity) and fluid collection around the heart. Nail polish Nail polish consists of a mix of an organic polymer and several other components that give it colors and textures. Nail disease Although the nail is a structure produced by the skin and is a skin appendage, nail diseases have a distinct classification as they have their own signs and symptoms which may relate to other medical conditions. The normal process of change is: brittle nails, straight nails, spoon-shaped A nail disease or onychosis is a disease or deformity of the nail. when the nail curves upwards (becomes spoon-shaped) due to an iron deficiency. Nail buffing A paste is used to fill ridges on nail surfaces. fill ridges on nail surfaces. However Nail buffing is the act of polishing the nail using buffers of successively finer grit in order to make nails look more consistent and shiny. Buffing is also done prior to the application of nail products or artificial nails to help the product adhere to the nail 807a62f83d

The medium grit can be used to smooth ridges and surface irregularities. This can be done before applying nail polish or as a first step before finer buffing. 807a62f83d == Structure == 807a62f83d The range is formed by mountains created by folds of the early Tertiary which remained relatively undisturbed after formation but have been heavily eroded. Their altitude is relatively moderate, the highest point of the range, Djebel Lazrag (ⵣⵉⵔ ⵙⵉⵔⵉⵔ), not even reaching 1,500 m. A nail holds materials together by friction in the axial direction and shear strength laterally. Modern instruments are much more efficient and are similar in appearance to a large rubber eraser, with different sides for different levels of coarseness. As buffing is gentle surface abrasion, it should not be performed too strongly or too often or thinning of the nail may result. 807a62f83d == Diseases == 807a62f83d == Signs and symptoms == 807a62f83d Some manicures include painting pictures or designs on the nails, applying small decals, or imitation jewels (from 2 dimensions to 3 dimensions). Other nail treatments may include the application of artificial gel nails, tips, or acrylics. 807a62f83d "The longitudinal striations can occur as a normal part of the aging process", and not until the nails start to thin and get a sandpaper look is the condition called trachonychia. The nails are opalescent and frequently are brittle and split at the free margin. There has been evidence of the condition as a cutaneous manifestation of lichen planus. It has also been associated with other diseases such as eczema, psoriasis, alopecia areata, and atopic dermatitis. Trachonychia When Trachonychia is a condition characterized by rough accentuated linear ridges (longitudinal striations) on the nails of the fingers and toes. When the condition occurs on all the twenty nails of the fingers and toes, it is known as twenty-nail dystrophy, most evident in childhood, favoring males. The term is from Greek τραχύς (trakhus) 'rough' and ὄνυξ (onyx) 'nail' 807a62f83d
