Kidney transplantation The first successful kidney transplant was performed in 1954 by a team including Joseph Murray, the recipient's surgeon, and Hartwell Harrison, surgeon for the donor. In 2018, an estimated 95,479 kidney transplants were performed worldwide, 36% of which came from living donors. Murray was awarded a Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine in 1990 for this and other work. Living-donor kidney transplants are further characterized as genetically related (living-related) or non-related (living-unrelated) transplants, depending on whether a biological relationship exists between the donor and recipient. Kidney transplant is typically classified as deceased-donor (formerly known as cadaveric) or living-donor transplantation depending on the source of the donor organ. Kidney They are located on the left and right in the retroperitoneal space, and in adult humans are about 12 centimetres (4+1/2 inches) in length. Each kidney is attached to a ureter, a tube that carries excreted urine to the bladder. the preceding two millennia. The kidney participates in the control of the volume of various body fluids, fluid osmolality, acid-base balance, various electrolyte concentrations, and removal of toxins. Filtration occurs in the glomerulus: one-fifth of the blood volume that enters the kidneys is filtered. Examples of substances reabsorbed are solute-free water, sodium, bicarbonate, glucose, and amino acids. Examples of substances secreted are hydrogen, ammonium, potassium and uric acid. The nephron is the structural and functional unit of the kidney. Each adult human kidney contains around 1 million nephrons, while a mouse kidney contains only about 12,500 nephrons. 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Quadrants and regions of abdomen The division into four quadrants allows the localisation of pain and tenderness, scars, lumps, and other items of interest, narrowing in on which organs and tissues may be involved. pancreas Right kidney and adrenal gland Hepatic flexure of colon The right lower quadrant (RLQ) extends from the median plane to the right of the patient The human abdomen is divided into quadrants and regions by anatomists and physicians for the purposes of study, diagnosis, and treatment. These terms are not used in comparative anatomy, since most other animals do not stand erect. The quadrants are referred to as the left lower quadrant, left upper quadrant, right upper quadrant and right lower quadrant 54e3227cd2
