However, this definition has been criticized for not being specific enough in regard to the nature of the bases (a cause of some confusion amongst generations of later geometry writers).

History == Traditionally prospecting relied on direct observation of mineralization in rock outcrops or in sediments. SPRM can achieve a sub-nanometer thickness sensitivity and lateral resolution achieves values of micrometer scale. SPRM is used to characterize surfaces such as self-assembled monolayers, multilayer films, metal nanoparticles, oligonucleotide arrays, and binding and reduction reactions. Surface plasmon polaritons are surface electromagnetic waves coupled to oscillating free electrons of a metallic surface that propagate along a metal/dielectric interface. Since polaritons are highly sensitive to small changes in the refractive index of the metallic material, it can be used as a biosensing tool that does not require labeling. Frequency selective surface In this sense, an FSS is a type of optical filter or metal-mesh optical filter in which the filtering is accomplished by virtue of the regular, periodic (usually metallic, but sometimes dielectric) pattern on the surface of the FSS. Though not explicitly mentioned in the name, FSSs also have properties which vary with incidence angle and polarization as well; these are unavoidable consequences of the way in which FSSs are constructed. Torre Insignia The building housed the headquarters of Banobras. The tower is not currently in use and is being renovated. It has been remodeled at least twice and houses one of the tallest carillon in the world, with 47 bells made by Petit & Fritsen. It is the tallest building in the Tlatelolco area and the third highest in the Avenida Insurgentes. At its completion in 1962, the tower became the second tallest building in Mexico after the Torre Latinoamericana. == Historical methods == a169719d00 The first experiments directed to give shooters optical aiming aids go back to the early 17th century. For centuries, different optical aiming aids and primitive predecessors of telescopic sights were created that had practical or performance limitations. Most early telescopic sights were fixed-power and were in essence specially designed viewing telescopes. Telescopic sights with variable magnifications appeared later, and were varied by manually adjusting a zoom mechanism behind the erector lenses.
