The cause of multiple myeloma is unknown. Risk factors include obesity, radiation exposure, family history, age and certain chemicals. There is an increased risk of multiple myeloma in certain occupations, due to occupational exposure to aromatic hydrocarbon solvents. Multiple myeloma is the result of a multi-step malignant transformation, and almost universally originates from the pre-malignant stage monoclonal gammopathy of undetermined significance (MGUS). As MGUS evolves into MM, another pre-stage of the disease is reached, known as smoldering myeloma (SMM). a19912f63e

Rabies In the Americas, bat bites are the most common source in humans, and less than 5% of Rabies is a viral disease that causes inflammation of the brain in humans and other mammals. The time depends on the distance the virus must travel along peripheral nerves to reach the central nervous system. The time period

between contracting the infection and the start of symptoms is usually one to three months but can vary from less than one week to more than one year. Once symptoms appear, the result is virtually always death. 99% of rabies cases in humans are the direct result of dog bites. Early symptoms can include fever and abnormal sensations at the site of exposure, which are followed by nausea, vomiting, violent movements, uncontrolled excitement, fear of water, inability to move parts of the body, confusion, and loss of consciousness a19912f63e

Diagnosis is challenging due to the mites' size, requiring microscopic identification by a medical entomologist, and the clinical symptoms often mimic other conditions, such as scabies or allergic reactions. The atypical or delayed responses to mite bites, coupled with widespread ignorance and misinformation among healthcare providers, scientists, and pest control professionals, contribute to frequent underdiagnosis and misdiagnosis, hindering effective management and treatment. a19912f63e == Causes == a19912f63e

It is spread when an infected animal bites or scratches a human or other animals. Even in the absence of a bite or a scratch, saliva from an infected animal coming into contact with the eyes, mouth, or nose can transmit rabies. Rabies can also be transmitted through tears and nervous tissues. Globally, dogs are the most common animal involved. Tick paralysis results from injection of a toxin from tick salivary glands during a blood meal after being attached for 3 to 7 days, causing fatigue within and weakness in both legs that progresses to paralysis. Deep tendon reflexes are usually decreased or absent. The paralysis ascends to the trunk, arms, and head, and may lead to respiratory failure and death. The disease can present as acute ataxia without muscle weakness. People may have minor sensory symptoms, such as local numbness, but no fever or headache or change in mental status. a19912f63e The most common sign of infection is an expanding red rash, known as erythema migrans (EM), which appears at the site of the tick bite about a week afterwards. develop a rash. Other early symptoms may include fever, headaches and tiredness. If untreated, symptoms may include loss of the ability to move one or both sides of the face, joint pains, severe headaches with neck stiffness or heart palpitations. Tick paralysis Tick paralysis results from injection of a toxin from tick salivary glands Tick paralysis is a type of paralysis caused by specific types of ticks reported mostly from the Americas, Asia, and Australia. Unlike other tick-borne diseases, the illness is caused by a neurotoxin produced in the tick's salivary gland. People can experience severe respiratory distress (similar to anaphylaxis). The incidence of tick paralysis is unknown. After prolonged attachment, the engorged tick transmits the toxin to its host, causing
