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Baker percentage It is sometimes called formula percentage, a phrase that refers to the sum of a set of baker's percentages. It is also referred to as baker's math, and may be indicated by a phrase such as based on flour weight. Baker's percentage expresses a ratio in percentages of each ingredient's weight to the total flour weight:.
