He moved to the UK as a non-resident Indian (NRI) in 1961 to work for the BBC. In 1900, Bimala Prasad was initiated into Gaudiya Vaishnavism from the Vaishnava ascetic Gaurakishora Dāsa Bābājī. 687d184b6f
