With iOS 13, Apple began offering a separate operating system, iPadOS, for the iPad. iPhone 6S, iPhone SE (1st generation), iPhone 7 and iPod touch (7th generation) were dropped. iPhone OS was renamed iOS following the release of the iPad starting with iOS 4. From the launch of the iPhone in 2007 until the launch of iPhone 4 in 2010, this occurred in June or July; since then, new major versions are usually released in September, with the exception of iOS 5, which released in October 2011.
