Vellus hair Exceptions include the lips, the back of the ear, the palm of the hand, the sole of the foot, some external genital areas, the navel, and scar tissue. The density of hair – the number of hair follicles per area of skin – varies from person to person. Trichostasis spinulosa – Diagnosed by observing Vellus hair (VELL-əs) is short, thin, light-colored, and barely noticeable hair that develops on most of a human's body during childhood. Each strand of vellus hair is usually less than 2 cm (10/13 inch) long, and the follicle is not connected to a sebaceous gland. terminal hair is usually shed after the birth of the baby upon the return of the hormones to the normal levels

Vellus hair is sometimes colloquially referred to as peach fuzz, for its resemblance to the downy growths (trichomes) on the skin of the peach fruit. In 2020, 1.34% of births took place outside of a hospital in California, USA, where 1 out of 8 births in the country happen. Most of the out-of-hospital births are planned, and thus, not considered an emergency childbirth. However, about 12% of attempted home deliveries need urgent transport to a hospital. Some of the reasons for transferring to a hospital include failure of labor to progress, parental exhaustion, need for more pain medication, or parental/fetal... Vellus hair is differentiated from the more visible terminal or androgenic hair, which develops only during and after puberty, usually to a greater extent on men than it does on women. Vellus hair replaces lanugo hair... Patterns in skin temperature often provide crucial diagnostic data on pathological conditions, ranging from locomotion to vascular diseases. Emergency childbirth In planned childbirth, mothers choose the location and obstetric team ahead of time. Sometimes, birth can occur on the way to these facilities, without a healthcare team. The rates of unplanned childbirth are low. Options range from delivering at home, at a hospital, a medical facility or a birthing center. If the birth is imminent, emergency measures may be needed. Drowning Most instances of fatal drowning occur alone or in situations where others present are either unaware of the victim's situation or unable to offer assistance. An incident of drowning can also cause further complications for victims due to low body temperature, aspiration, or acute respiratory distress syndrome (respiratory failure from lung inflammation). Occasionally, victims may not begin experiencing these symptoms until several hours after they are rescued. below body temperature should attempt resuscitation even after protracted immersion. After successful resuscitation, drowning victims may experience breathing problems, confusion, or unconsciousness. Submersion injury refers to both drowning and near-miss incidents. The treatment of mild hypothermia involves warm drinks, warm clothing, and voluntary... fcd7e978e Drowning is more likely to happen when spending extended periods near large bodies of water. Risk factors for drowning include alcohol use, drug use, epilepsy, minimal swim training or a complete lack of training, and, in the case of children, a lack of supervision. Common drowning locations include natural and man-made bodies of water, bathtubs, and swimming pools. fcd7e978e Hypothermia has two main types of causes. It classically occurs from exposure to cold weather and cold water immersion. It may also occur from any condition that decreases heat production or increases heat loss. Commonly, this includes alcohol intoxication but may also include low blood sugar, anorexia, and advanced age. Body temperature is usually maintained near a constant level of 36.5–37.5 °C (97.7–99.5 °F) through thermoregulation. Efforts to increase body temperature involve shivering, increased voluntary activity, and putting on warmer clothing. Hypothermia may be diagnosed by either a person's symptoms in the presence of risk factors or measuring a person's core temperature. fcd7e978e
