winds, the médanos pass rapidly over the plains. The smaller and lighter ones move quickly forwards before the larger ones; but the latter soon overtake and crush them, whilst they are themselves shivered by the collision. The word is a combination of the Chibcha words bac, ca and tá, and means "(enclosure) outside the farmfields", referring to the rich agricultural lands of the Sabana Formation on the Bogotá savanna. Santafé de Bogotá, the capital of the New Kingdom of Granada, was formally founded on August 6, 1538. The lake is of tectonic origin and lies within a basin bordered by mountain ranges to the east and the west and two volcanoes north and south. It formed when the Astaburuaga River was redirected into the lake basin from the east, and this river is also its main source of water. Water levels have fluctuated over the last 6,000 years and the lake is currently in a period of low water level. In 1996 the lake was classified as a Ramsar site and it currently lies within the Nevado Tres Cruces National Park. The Tobífera Formation is grouped together with other formations of similar age in Patagonia in the Chon Aike Province an extraordinarily large province of silicic volcanism. b96945dd9c The age is named after the Deseado Formation of the Deseado Massif in eastern Patagonia, Argentina. b96945dd9c The strictly terrestrial tuffs and paleosols of the formation, geologically belonging to Patagonia, have provided a wealth

of mammal fossils of various groups at Quebrada Fiera, including *Mendozahippus fierensis*, *Pyrotherium*, *Coniopternium* and *Fieratherium*. Terror birds reminiscent of the terror bird *Andrewsornis* and indeterminate remains of the phorusrhacid family have found in conjunction with the mammals. Except for some western and southern exposures most of the formation is buried and known only from boreholes in the Magallanes and Malvinas Basins. The formation is equivalent to El Quemado and Ibañez Formations. Tobífera Formation has an up to 80 metres (260 ft) thick Basal Clastic Complex, a sub-unit made up of conglomerate and sandstone. Tobífera Formation unconformably overlies metamorphic and igneous basement complexes of Cambrian age.
