He also starred in the 1958 western *Fort Dobbs*, with Clint Walker and Virginia Mayo and *The 7th Voyage of Sinbad* in 1958, in which he portrayed the metallic-voiced Barani the Genie. They are small to large, dioecious palms, with solitary, robust grey stems, swollen at base and gradually tapering upward. The species vary greatly in size, with *R. hildebrandtii* and *R. nana* only reaching 4 m, while *R. robustior* and *R. sambiranensis* both reach 30 m. The leaves are up to 2–5 m long, pinnately compound, reduplicate, erect at first then arching, twisted near the apex; with numerous crowded narrow ribbed leaflets. The inflorescence is short, borne among the

leaves; the fruit is a red drupe. One particular species, *Ravenea rivularis*, is commonly cultivated as a houseplant and grown indoors all over the world. However, it is actually considered a vulnerable species in its wild habitat with fewer than 900 trees growing naturally. The palm leaves in the crest are a symbol of victory included as a compliment from the Council to the valour of Australian Defence Force.
