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In order to combat the worldwide epidemic of childhood obesity it is imperative that the issue is addressed in its early stages. The main preventative measures to be implemented include increasing physical exercise, dietary knowledge and decreasing sedentary behaviours. **Measuring obesity...** People react to similar events differently. Most people... **Short-term reactions** such as psychological shock and psychological denial typically follow. Long-term reactions and effects include flashbacks, panic attacks, insomnia, nightmare disorder, difficulties with interpersonal relationships, emotional dysregulation, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), and brief psychotic disorder. Physical symptoms including migraines, hyperventilation, hyperhidrosis, and nausea are often associated with or made worse by trauma. **Background** **Symptoms** children may have while exposed to domestic violence **Health** **Collective trauma** is when psychological trauma experienced by communities and identity groups is carried on as part of the group's collective memory and shared sense of identity. For example, collective trauma was experienced by Jewish Holocaust survivors and their contemporaries within the wider Jewish community. As another example, the Indigenous Peoples of Canada experienced it within the Canadian Indian residential school system. African Americans who were enslaved is another. When this

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collective trauma affects subsequent generations, it is called transgenerational trauma. For example, when Jewish people, who are born into a later generation, learn about the Holocaust (presumably from older family members), and then experience extreme stress or practice survivalism out of fear of another Holocaust. bfa64fdeff

Undernutrition in children Undernutrition is sometimes used synonymously with malnutrition, however, malnutrition could mean both undernutrition or overnutrition (causing childhood obesity). It is common globally and may result in both short and long term irreversible adverse health outcomes. malnutrition during the age of rapid development, which can have long-lasting impacts on health. Another estimate, also by WHO, states that childhood underweight is the cause for about 35% of all deaths of children under the age of five worldwide. The World Health Organization (WHO) estimates that malnutrition accounts for 54 percent of child mortality worldwide, which is about 1 million children. Hospitals can and should diagnose, manage and prioritize treatments Undernutrition in children, occurs when children do not consume enough calories, protein, or micronutrients to maintain good health bfa64fdeff

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Transgenerational trauma can... For Australians aged between 4 and 17 years, obesity is a very concerning condition as once gained it is favourably harder to be liberated from. Short-term effects on children can mean a decrease in their psychological well-being (stigmatisation and poor self-esteem) as well as physical deteriorations such as sleep apnea, breathlessness and cardiovascular disease. With an increase risk of adult obesity being associated with childhood obesity there are numerous long-term effects that can ultimately hinder the life expectancy of individuals including the development of serious diseases.

Childhood trauma They may also witness abuse of a sibling or parent, or have a mentally ill parent. Childhood trauma is often described as serious adverse childhood experiences. Childhood trauma has been correlated with later negative effects on health and psychological wellbeing. Children may go through a range of experiences that classify as psychological trauma; these might include neglect, abandonment, sexual abuse, emotional abuse, and physical abuse. Children's ages and levels of maturity play a role in how they are impacted by trauma. However, resilience is also a common outcome; many children who experience adverse childhood experiences do not develop mental or physical health problems. Children may go through a range of

Children can be exposed to domestic The effects of domestic violence on children have a tremendous impact on the well-being and developmental growth of children witnessing it. Children who are exposed to domestic violence in the home often believe that they are to blame, live in a constant state of fear, and are 15 times more likely to be victims of child abuse. Close observation during an interaction can alert providers to the need for further investigation and intervention, such as dysfunctions in the physical, behavioral, emotional, and social areas of life, and can aid in early intervention and assistance for child victims. Children can be exposed to domestic violence in a multitude of ways and goes beyond witnessing or overhearing, although there is disagreement in how it should be measured bfa64fdeff

A few stressors can be manageable for young children; stress can be beneficial by helping children develop skills needed to adapt to a new set of circumstances and deal with dangerous and intimidating situations. Some experts have theorized that there is a point where prolonged or excessive stress becomes harmful and can lead to serious health effects. When stress builds up in early childhood, neurobiological factors are affected. In turn, levels of the stress hormone cortisol exceed normal ranges. This theory however is based on animal studies and cross-sectional studies in humans, and the proposed impacts on brain centers have not been found in a landmark twin study and studies where neurobiological factors were measured in humans prior to stress or trauma exposure. bfa64fdeff

Psychological trauma Examples of distressing events include exposure to violence, sexual assault or rape, childhood abuse, the death of a loved one, or mass casualty events such as terrorist attacks or natural disasters. 5% were survivors of four or more ACEs. A trauma-informed Psychological trauma (also known as mental trauma,

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psychiatric trauma, emotional damage, or psychotrauma) is an emotional response caused by severe distressing events, such as bodily injury, sexual violence, or other threats to the life of the subject or their loved ones; indirect exposure, such as from watching television news, may be extremely distressing and can produce an involuntary and possibly overwhelming physiological stress response, but does not always produce trauma. participants in the Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) study were survivors of one ACE and 12 bfa64fdeff

Closures are estimated to have lasted for an average of 41 weeks (10.3 months).
