**Yabucoa, Puerto Rico** It is part of the San Juan-Caguas-Guaynabo Metropolitan Statistical Area. "Yabucoa, el primer pueblo impactado por María, lucha por salir de la depresión". Yabucoa is spread over 9 barrios and Yabucoa Pueblo (the downtown area and the administrative center of the city). Archived from the original Yabucoa (Spanish pronunciation: [jaβu'koa]) is a town and municipality in Puerto Rico located in the eastern region, north of Maunabo; south of San Lorenzo, Las Piedras and Humacao; and east of Patillas. Some nicknames of the city are "Sugar City", after the numerous sugarcane plantations of the Yabucoa Valley, and Pueblo de Yuca ("Yuca Town") which references the Taíno origin of the name of the town. The locals are also known as the Bebe Leches ("milk drinkers") after the numerous dairy farms located in the region. His career as a dramatist began at the university, where he directed the Theater of the Faculty of Medicine from 1974 to 1976, and became known as a playwright. In 1975 he received an honorable mention in the university's dramaturgy competition for *Matatangos*, *disparen sobre el zorzal*, which would be released three years later. Moizeszowicz was a Resident Physician at the University of Buenos Aires Medical Clinic Research Institute from 1965 to 1968. He worked with the team that performed the first kidney transplants. He was also involved in the first Balint Society group for psychotherapists in Argentina. Books published include *Hilandera de tramas* (2012), *Lazareto de Afecciones* (2018), and *Al borde de la decencia* (2019). Other stories have been published in different anthologies internationally. Gómez has participated in the "Palenque" anthology, winner of the 2014 Puerto Rican PEN Club Literature Prize, with her story: *Hacinamiento*.
