Codeine It is commonly used as a recreational drug. Codeine exhibits abuse potential similar to other opioid medications, including a risk of addiction and overdose. Greater benefit may occur when combined with paracetamol (acetaminophen) as codeine/paracetamol or a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) such as aspirin or ibuprofen. Evidence does not support its use for acute cough suppression in children. In Europe, it is not recommended as a cough medicine for those under 12 years of age. It is found naturally in the sap of the opium poppy, *Papaver somniferum*.
