It measures above sea level, of course, but within that there was very little elevation change. This influenced how the battle was fought, obviously. Around 1982, a newer category-ratio scale, the Borg CR-10 scale was published. It used a scale from 0-11+. items (usually eight or more), and the format in which responses are scored along a range. Technically speaking, a Likert scale refers only to the former. The difference between these two concepts has to do with the distinction Likert made between the underlying phenomenon being investigated and the means of capturing variation that points to the underlying phenomenon.
