== History ==

Lục bát It will always begin with a six-syllable line and end with an eight-syllable one. A customer "Eeny, meeny, miny, moe" – which can be spelled a number of ways – is a children's counting-out rhyme, used to select a person in games such as tag, or for selecting various other things. Some versions use a racial slur, which has made the rhyme controversial at times

rhyme groups. Each rhyme group was subdivided into homophone groups preceded by a small circle called a niǔ (鈕, 'button'). The pronunciation of each homophone group was indicated by a fǎnqiè formula, a pair of characters having respectively the same initial and final sound as the word being described. By systematically analysing the fanqie, it is possible to identify equivalent initial and final spellers, and thus enumerate the initials and finals, but not their phonetic values. Rime tables such as the Yunjing further analysed the syllables distinguished by the rime dictionaries into initial consonant, 'open' (kāi 開) or 'closed' (hé 合), divisions (I-IV), broad rhyme class and tone. The closed distinction is generally considered to represent lip rounding.

447d8f3b42 Unlike other verse forms which are traditionally enjoyed only by high-class Vietnamese, lục bát is traditionally composed and enjoyed by people of all classes, from the lowly peasants to the noble princes. It can be regarded as a living style of Vietnamese people. The rich treasure of Vietnamese folk poems (ca dao), which consists of hundred thousands of verses that reflect on life, morality, human relationships, and natural beauty, is almost entirely composed in lục bát form. The 3,774 verses in "Đại Nam Quốc Sử Diễn Ca" (chữ Hán: 大南國史演歌; Epic Song of National History) composed by Vietnamese poet Lê Ngô Cát under the reign of Emperor Tự Đức are also entirely in the form of lục bát. == Distribution == 447d8f3b42 With the exception of free poetry, a form with no distinct structure, other forms all have a certain structure. The tightest and most rigid structure was that of the Tang dynasty poetry, in which structures of content, number of syllables per line, lines per poem, rhythm rule determined the form of the poem.
