Ultraviolet It is also produced by electric arcs, Cherenkov radiation, and specialized lights, such as mercury-vapor lamps, tanning lamps, and black lights. UV radiation is present in sunlight and constitutes about 10% of the total electromagnetic radiation output from the Sun. The chemical compound dihydroxyacetone (DHA) is used in sunless tanning products in concentrations of 3%-5%. DHA concentration is adjusted to provide darker and lighter shades of tan. The reaction of keratin protein present in

skin and DHA is responsible for the production of pigmentation. Over time, metabolic changes of the crystalline lens fibres lead to the development of a cataract, causing impairment or loss of vision. Some infants are born with congenital cataracts, and environmental factors may lead to cataract formation. Early symptoms may include glare from lights, especially at night, blunting of colors in vision and reduced visual acuity at low light levels.

Zinc oxide Although it occurs naturally as the mineral zincite, most zinc oxide is produced synthetically. 5% iron(III) oxide (Fe_2O_3) is called calamine and is used in calamine lotion, a topical skin treatment. ZnO is used as an additive in numerous materials and products including cosmetics, food supplements, rubbers, plastics, ceramics, glass, cement, lubricants, paints, sunscreens, ointments, calamine, adhesives, sealants, pigments, foods, batteries, ferrites, fire retardants, semi conductors, and first-aid tapes. == A == DHA is a hygroscopic white crystalline powder. It has a sweet cooling taste and a characteristic odor. It is the simplest of all ketoses and has no chiral center. The normal form is a dimer (2,5-bis(hydroxymethyl)-1,4-

dioxane-2,5-diol). The dimer slowly dissolves in water, whereupon it converts to the monomer. These solutions are stable at pH's between 4 and 6. In more basic solution, it degrades into brown product. cf4fb43c8c Some early cosmetics contained harmful ingredients, such as lead, which caused serious health problems and sometimes resulted in death. == History == cf4fb43c8c The tanning effect of dihydroxyacetone (DHA) was discovered in the 1950s by Eva Wittgenstein at Cincinnati Children's Hospital, who observed that DHA used in an oral treatment stained the skin brown on contact. The first commercial DHA self-tanner, Man-Tan, appeared in 1959, followed by Coppertone's "QT" (Quick Tan) in 1960; both produced an orange-toned result that gave early self-tanners a poor reputation.

(intraocular lens) is usually implanted in its place (PCIOL), or less frequently in the ciliary sulcus, to restore clear vision. Cataract surgery is performed by an ophthalmologist in an out-patient setting at a surgical centre or hospital.

Local anaesthesia (injection) or topical anesthesia (drops) are normally used. The procedure is usually quick and causes little or no pain and minor discomfort. Zinc oxide ointment is also mentioned by the Greek physician Dioscorides (1st century AD). Galen suggested treating ulcerating cancers with zinc oxide, as did Avicenna in his The Canon of Medicine. Although long-wavelength ultraviolet is not considered an ionizing radiation because its photons lack sufficient energy, it can induce chemical reactions and cause many substances to glow or fluoresce. Many practical applications,

including chemical and biological effects, are derived from the way that UV radiation can interact with organic molecules. These interactions can involve exciting orbital electrons to higher energy states in molecules potentially breaking... cf4fb43c8c
