Lyme disease Infections are most common in the spring and early summer. It is the most common disease spread by ticks in the Northern Hemisphere. Most treated patients experience a full recovery. Persistent fever or compatible anomalous Lyme disease, also known as Lyme borreliosis, is a tick-borne disease caused by species of *Borrelia* bacteria, transmitted by blood-feeding ticks in the genus *Ixodes*. since they may resolve on their own or—as in the case of HGA—can be treated with the doxycycline prescribed for Lyme. Mycoplasma genitalium The bacterium was first isolated from the urogenital tract of humans in 1981 and was identified as a new species of *Mycoplasma* in 1983. It increases the risk of HIV spread in men and women, with higher occurrences in those previously treated with azithromycin antibiotics.
