== Bottling lines == Efforts to consolidate the many local systems led to the North German Confederation's Weights and Measures Ordinance of 17 August 1868. It set the metre and kilogram as the common standards and, after a transition period, made the metric system mandatory from 1 January 1872. For merchants, this meant converting or replacing existing measures, weights, and scales; instruments approved for trade use were checked against the new official standards and stamped as verified. Unit price Average prices can be calculated by weighting different unit selling prices by the percentage of unit sales (mix) for each product variant. When one product is sold in variants, such as bottle sizes, managers must define "comparable" units. The "unit price" tells the buyer the cost per pound, quart, or other unit of weight A product's average price is the result of dividing the product's total sales revenue by the total units sold. If we use a standard, rather than an actual mix of sizes and product varieties, the result is price per statistical unit. Statistical units are also called equivalent units. unit of measure of a product sold in more or less than the single unit

The original French metric system used the litre as a base unit. The word litre is derived from an older French unit, the litron, whose name came from Byzantine Greek—where it was a unit of weight, not volume—via Late Medieval Latin, and which equalled approximately 0.82 litres. The litre was also used in several subsequent versions of the metric system but is not an SI unit; the SI unit of volume is the cubic metre (m³). The spelling used by the International Bureau of Weights and Measures is "litre", a spelling which is shared by most English-speaking countries. The spelling "liter" is predominantly used in American English. As an agricultural product, milk is collected from farm animals, mostly cattle, on a dairy. The U.S. has a national policy to adopt the metric system. Under Executive Order 12770, signed in 1991 by President George H.W. Bush, all U.S. agencies were required to adopt the

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metric system. However, conversion was made not mandatory, so U.S. customary units remain in common use in government (for example, speed limits are still posted in miles per hour) and in many industries. There is government policy and metric (SI) program to implement and assist with metrication, but there is strong social resistance to further metrication. The metric system became compulsory in Austria on 1 January 1876. The names are often the same as for the units used to measure liquids, despite representing different volumes. The larger volumes of the dry measures apparently arose because they were based on heaped rather than "struck" (leveled) containers.

There are many ways that paint can be recycled. Most often, the highest quality of latex paint is sorted out and turned back into recycled paint that can be used.
