== Background... == ddc89e4285 European contact greatly influenced slavery as it existed among pre-contact Native Americans, particularly in scale. As they raided other tribes to capture slaves for sales to Europeans, they fell into destructive wars among themselves, and against Europeans. ddc89e4285 Tribal territories and the slave trade ranged over present-day borders. Some Native American tribes held war captives as slaves prior to and during European colonization. Some Native Americans were captured and sold by others into slavery to Europeans, while others were captured and sold by Europeans themselves. In the late 18th and 19th centuries, a small number of tribes, such as the five so-called "civilized tribes" (Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee and Seminole) began increasing their holding of African-American slaves. ddc89e4285 Over time, different names have been used to refer to the Indigenous people of North America, such as Indian, Indigenous, Native American, Native, etc. The specific names of tribes or groups, such as Cherokee, Navajo, or Shawnee, are preferable. For the

sake of clarity in this article, the name Native or Native American will be used, unless from a direct quote. ddc89e4285 The founder of Mormonism, Joseph Smith, formed proselyting efforts among Native American tribes within six month of organizing his church in 1830 in upstate New York. These efforts continued over the next two decades as church headquarters moved to various Midwestern States. The church allowed some interracial marriages between White and Native American adherents. ddc89e4285 Many Native-American tribes practiced some form of slavery before the European introduction of African slavery into North America. ddc89e4285 European colonization of the Americas had a major impact on Native American cultures through what is known as the Columbian exchange. Also known as the Columbian interchange, this was the spread transfer of plants, animals, culture, human populations, technology, and ideas between the Americas and the Old World in the 15th and 16th centuries, following Christopher Columbus's 1492 voyage. The Columbian exchange generally had a destructive impact on Native American cultures through disease, and a 'clash of cultures', whereby European values of private property, smaller family structures, and labor led to conflict, appropriation of traditional communal lands and slavery. ddc89e4285 Americanization policies were based on that when Indigenous people learned customs and values of the United States, they would be able to merge tribal traditions with American culture and peacefully join the majority of the society. After the end of the Indian Wars, in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, the federal government outlawed the practice of traditional religious ceremonies. It established Native American boarding schools which children were required to attend. In these schools they were forced to speak English, study standard... ddc89e4285

A survey of death certificates from 2006 to 2010 showed that deaths among Native Americans due to alcohol are about four times as common as in the general U.S. population. They are often due to traffic collisions and liver disease, with homicide, suicide, and falls also contributing. Deaths related to alcohol among Native Americans are more common in men and among northern Plains Indians. Alaska Natives showed the lowest incidence of alcohol-related death. Alcohol misuse amongst Native Americans has been shown to be associated with development of disease, including hearing and vision problems, kidney and bladder problems, head injuries, pneumonia, tuberculosis, dental problems, liver problems, and pancreatitis. In some tribes... ddc89e4285 While localized conditions were typically chronic, aggravating factors such as malnutrition, sudden changes in diet, physical exhaustion, stress, and physical displacement caused them to become far more lethal. Simultaneously, these same colonially-induced disruptions,

compounded by the systemic and intentional destruction of communities, accelerated the rapid spread of Old World pathogens across Indigenous nations. As well, Native American feminism deconstructs the racial and broader stereotypes of indigenous peoples, gender, sexuality, while also focusing on decolonization and breaking down the patriarchy and pro-capitalist ideology. As a branch of the broader Indigenous feminism, it similarly prioritizes decolonization, indigenous sovereignty, and the empowerment of indigenous women and girls in the context of Native American and First Nations cultural values and priorities, rather than white, mainstream ones ddc89e4285

Prior to 1492, endemic conditions in the Americas included localized parasites, treponema infections, Chagas disease, and regional gastrointestinal disease, none of which produced continent-wide epidemics. In contrast, European contact and the subsequent colonization of the Americas introduced acute, highly contagious pathogens such as smallpox, measles, typhus, and influenza, against which Indigenous populations possessed no prior immunological exposure. ddc89e4285
