The dish was created by, and named after, Mexican restaurateur Ignacio "Nacho" Anaya, who created it in 1943 for American customers at the Victory Club restaurant in Piedras Negras, Coahuila. At its most basic form, nachos may consist of merely chips covered with melted cheese (usually cheddar or

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American cheese), or cheese sauce and served as an appetizer or snack, while other versions are substantial enough to serve as a main course. A single serving Nachos are a Tex-Mex dish consisting of tortilla chips or totopos covered with cheese or chile con queso, as well as a variety of other toppings and garnishes, often including meats (such as ground beef or grilled chicken), vegetables (such as chili peppers, lettuce, tomatoes, and olives), and condiments such as salsa, guacamole, or sour cream. All in all, a single serving of nachos can contain from 300 to 600 total calories

History == Textured vegetable protein was invented by the agricultural commodities and food processing company Archer Daniels Midland in the 1960s, in Chicago, Illinois, the U.S.; the company owns the name "textured vegetable protein" and the acronym TVP as registered trademarks. Archer Daniels Midland had developed a textured soy protein isolate made with an extruder in the shape of rods or tubes. The soy protein isolate was produced in a small pilot plant and sold for use in Chili con carne, but the product was not commercially successful. By 1968, TVP was widely used in a variety of food products, and consumption skyrocketed after 1971, when TVP was approved for use...

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
