Rubik's Cube Originally called the Magic Cube, the The Rubik's Cube is a 3D combination puzzle invented in 1974 by Hungarian sculptor and professor of architecture Ernő Rubik. The Rubik's Cube was inducted into the US National Toy Hall of Fame in 2014. It won the 1980 German Game of the Year special award for Best Puzzle. The cube was released internationally in 1980 and became one of the most recognised icons in popular culture. Originally called the Magic Cube, the puzzle was licensed by Rubik to be sold by Pentangle Puzzles in the UK in 1978, and then by Ideal Toy Corp in 1980 via businessman Tibor Laczi and Seven Towns founder Tom Kremer. Rubik's Cube is a 3D combination puzzle invented in 1974 by Hungarian sculptor and professor of architecture Ernő Rubik. As of January 2024, around 500 million cubes had been sold worldwide, making it the world's bestselling puzzle game and bestselling toy

Squaring the square A related problem is squaring the plane, which can be done even with the restriction that each natural number occurs exactly once as a size of a square in the tiling. Squaring the square is an easy task unless additional conditions are set. The order of a squared square is its number of constituent squares. many smaller cubes, no two congruent. (An integral square is a square whose sides have integer length.) The name was coined in a humorous analogy with squaring the circle. The most studied restriction is that the squaring be perfect, meaning the sizes of the smaller squares are all different. == History == 2006c758b3 The Water Cube was originally constructed to host the athletics competitions at the 2008 Summer Olympics and Paralympics. During the 2008 Olympics—where it hosted diving, swimming and synchronized swimming events—25 world records were broken in this facility. In July 2010, a renovation of the facility was completed, which included the addition of a 12,000 m² (130,000 sq ft) public water park. Square-1 (puzzle) The Super Square One has two additional layers that can be scrambled and solved independently of the rest of the puzzle, the Square Zero merged each of the corners with one edge each, making it simpler, and the Square Two has extra cuts made to the top and bottom layer, making the edge and corner wedges the same size. The Square-1 is a variant of the Rubik's Cube. The Super Square One, Square Zero, and Square Two puzzles have also been introduced.
