Ethnic groups in Cambodia other than the politically and socially dominant Khmer are classified as either "indigenous ethnic minorities" or "non-indigenous ethnic minorities". The indigenous ethnic minorities, more commonly collectively referred to as the Khmer Loeu ("upland Khmer"), constitute the majority in the remote mountainous provinces of Ratanakiri, Mondulakiri and Stung Treng and are present in substantial numbers in Kratie Province. d589da3925

Ethnic groups in Bosnia and Herzegovina The most easily recognisable feature that distinguishes the three ethnic groups is their religion, with Bosniaks predominantly Muslim, Serbs predominantly Eastern Orthodox, and Croats Catholic. A significant minority are Melanesian peoples, descendants of some of the earliest modern humans to inhabit Southeast Asia, mostly found in eastern Indonesia. Unrecognized ethnic groups in China There are in addition small distinct ethnic groups that have been classified as part of larger ethnic groups that are officially recognized. Although they are indigenous to Hainan island and do not speak a Chinese language, the Lingao (Ong-Be) people near the capital (8% of the population) are counted as Han Chinese. For example, in Gansu, Han individuals may have genetic traits from the assimilated Tangut civilization. A number of ethnic groups of the People's Republic of China are not officially recognized. Han Chinese, being the world's largest ethnic group, has great diversity within it. Some groups, like the Hui of Xinjiang with the Hui of Fujian, are geographically and culturally separate, except for the shared belief of Islam. Taken together, these groups (simplified Chinese: 维族; traditional Chinese: 維族; pinyin: wèi shíbié mínzú) would constitute the twentieth most populous ethnic group of China.
