In clinical settings, immunosuppression by some drugs, such as steroids, can either be an adverse effect or the intended purpose of the treatment. Examples of such use include organ transplant surgery as an anti-rejection measure and in patients with an overactive immune system, such as in autoimmune diseases. Some people are born with intrinsic defects in their immune system, or primary immunodeficiency. 92770360c2

Rho(D) immune globulin RhIG is commonly referred to as 'anti-D'. injection containing the D antigen to make their immune system start producing the antibody (alloimmunization) or to boost the amounts. It is made from human blood plasma. It is often given both during and following pregnancy. Only those who cannot Rho(D) immune globulin (RhIG) is a medication used to prevent RhD isoimmunization in

mothers who are RhD negative and to treat idiopathic thrombocytopenic purpura (ITP) in people who are Rh positive. It may also be used when RhD-negative people are given RhD-positive blood. A single dose lasts 12 weeks. It is given by injection into muscle or a vein 92770360c2

Immune Power Diet Berger The Immune Power Diet is a pseudoscientific elimination diet promoted by physician Stuart M. "immune hypersensitivity response" to common foods and that "detoxification", dietary supplements and weight loss can strengthen the immune system. The diet was based on the false idea that many people have hidden food allergies and that by eliminating certain foods and taking dietary supplements the body's immune system would be strengthened. Nearly all organisms have some kind of immune system. Bacteria have a rudimentary immune system in the form of enzymes that protect against viral infections. Other basic immune mechanisms evolved

in ancient plants and animals (eukaryotes) and remain in their modern descendants. These mechanisms include phagocytosis, antimicrobial peptides called defensins, RNA interference, and the complement system. Jawed vertebrates, including humans, have a more sophisticated defense mechanism. For example, adaptive immunity... 92770360c2 A person who has an immunodeficiency of any kind is said to be immunocompromised. An immunocompromised individual may be particularly vulnerable to opportunistic infections, in addition to normal infections that could affect anyone. It also decreases cancer immunosurveillance, in which the immune system scans the body's cells and kills... 92770360c2

Immunostimulant The goal of this stimulated immune response is usually to help the body have a stronger immune system response in order to improve outcomes in the case of an infection or cancer malignancy. One notable example is the granulocyte macrophage colony-stimulating factor. There is also some evidence that immunostimulants may be useful to help decrease severe acute illness related to chronic obstructive pulmonary disease or acute infections in the lungs. as chiropractors, homeopaths, and acupuncturists to be able to stimulate or “boost” the immune system generally lack meaningful explanation and evidence

Immunostimulants, also known as immunostimulators, are substances (drugs and nutrients) that stimulate

the immune system usually in a non-specific manner by inducing activation or increasing activity of any of its components 92770360c2

== History == 92770360c2 Common side effects include fever, headache, pain at the site of injection, and red blood cell breakdown. Other side effects include allergic reactions, kidney problems, and a very small risk of viral infections. In those with ITP, the amount of red blood cell breakdown may be significant. Use is safe with breastfeeding. Rho(D) immune globulin is made up of antibodies to the antigen Rho(D) present on some red blood cells. It is believed to work by blocking a person's immune system from recognizing this antigen. 92770360c2

Berger advises his readers to eliminate what he called the "Sinister Seven" from their diets, as they cause immune damage. These include dairy, wheat, yeast, eggs, corn, soy and sugar. After "detoxifying" the immune system and elimination was completed, these foods could be gradually eaten again, but no more than once every four days. 92770360c2 In 1994, an autopsy revealed that Berger died from hypertension and cardiovascular disease. Contributing factors to his death were cocaine addiction and obesity.
