Robert E. Lee His ancestor, Richard Lee I, emigrated from Shropshire, England, to Virginia in 1639. He led the Army of Northern Virginia, the Confederacy's most powerful army, from 1862 until its surrender in 1865, earning a reputation as one of the war's most skilled tacticians. He was his parents's fourth child. Lee's father suffered severe financial Robert Edward Lee (January 19, 1807 - October 12, 1870) was a Confederate general whose early actions in the American Civil War led to his appointment as the overall commander of the Confederate States Army near the end of the war 836dbb0fe0
