

# Azelaic Acid Before And After

Schorlemmer was born on 30 September 1834 in Darmstadt, German Confederation, the son of a joiner. He was able to visit Realschule and later — against the will of his poor father — trade school. As a teenager, he participated in the German revolutions of 1848–1849 in Baden.

**Pimple** Pimples can be treated by acne medications, antibiotics, and anti-inflammatories prescribed by a physician, or various over the counter remedies purchased at a pharmacy. In its aggravated state, it may evolve into a pustule or papule. Historically, antibiotics such as tetracyclines and erythromycin were prescribed. **Carl Schorlemmer** He was a professor of chemistry at Owens College, Manchester and a fellow of the Royal Society (1871) and the American Philosophical Society (1878). particularly their chlorides and bromides and isomerism, he studied the compounds aurin, rosaniline, suberone, azelaic acid, and safranin, and he also began to publish. Carl Schorlemmer FRS (30 September 1834 – 27 June 1892) was a German and British chemist who did research on hydrocarbons, particularly paraffins, and was a pioneer in the study of the history of chemistry. He was also a revolutionary of 1848, an early Communist, and a personal friend of Karl Marx and Friedrich Engels who was one of the thirteen people to attend Marx's funeral; he is sometimes known as "the red chemist."

**Mupirocin** It may also be used to get rid of methicillin-resistant *S. aureus* (MRSA) when present in the nose without symptoms. It is used as a cream or ointment applied to the skin. Out of concerns of developing resistance, use for greater than ten days is not recommended. against MuH strains. Other antibiotic agents, such as azelaic acid, nitrofurazone, silver sulfadiazine, and ramoplanin, have been shown to be effective against Mupirocin, sold under the brand name Bactroban among others, is a topical antibiotic useful against superficial skin infections such as impetigo or folliculitis

== Causes == CGPD is characterized by the presence of small, raised, dome-shaped, flesh-colored or yellow-brown papules primarily distributed around the mouth, eyes, and nose. Affected children may also have papules on the ears, eyelids, cheeks, forehead, and nose. CGPD skin lesions rarely affect areas of the skin other than the face. **Isotretinoin** Isotretinoin is used off-label to treat basal cell carcinoma and squamous cell carcinoma, although clinical evidence suggests it is not effective in this setting. Its isomer, tretinoin, is also an acne drug. It is a retinoid, meaning it is related to vitamin A, and is found in small quantities naturally in the body. Isotretinoin, also known as 13-cis-retinoic acid and sold under the brand name Accutane among others, is a medication used to treat skin diseases like Isotretinoin, also known as 13-cis-retinoic acid

Sebaceous glands inside the pore of the skin produce sebum. When the outer layers of skin shed (a natural and continuous process, normally), dead skin and oily sebum left behind may bond together and form a blockage of the sebaceous gland at the base of the skin. This is most common when the skin becomes thicker at puberty. The sebaceous gland continues to produce sebum, which builds up behind the blockage, allowing bacteria to grow in the area, including the species *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Cutibacterium acnes*, which causes inflammation and infection. Other causes of pimples include family history, stress, fluctuations in hormone levels, hair and skincare products, medication side effects, and un-diagnosed or underlying medical conditions. **Ozonolysis** The outcome of the reaction depends on the type of multiple bond being oxidized and the work-up conditions. facilitate timely cleavage of the ozonide. An example is In organic chemistry, ozonolysis is an organic reaction where the unsaturated bonds are cleaved with ozone (O<sub>3</sub>). Multiple carbon-carbon bond are replaced by carbonyl (C=O) groups, such as aldehydes, ketones, and carboxylic acids. The reaction is predominantly applied to alkenes, but alkynes and azo compounds are also susceptible to cleavage. Azelaic acid and pelargonic acids are produced from ozonolysis of oleic acid on an industrial scale 21afcebdd1

**Comedo-type ductal carcinoma in situ (DCIS)** is not related to the skin conditions discussed here. DCIS is a noninvasive form of breast cancer, but comedo-type DCIS may be more aggressive, so may be more likely to become invasive. 21afcebdd1

**Comedo** before starting the drug and during treatment. A comedo can be open (blackhead) or closed by skin (whitehead) and occur with or without acne. The word comedo comes from Latin comedere 'to eat up' and was historically used to describe parasitic worms; in modern medical terminology, it is used to suggest the worm-like appearance of the expressed material. Keratin (skin debris) combines with oil to block the follicle. Raw vegetable oil, obtained from seeds by pressing, solvent extraction, contains free fatty acids and other components such as phospholipids, waxes, peroxides, aldehydes, and ketones, which contribute to undesirable flavor, odor, and appearance; for these reasons, all the oil has to be refined. 21afcebdd1

**Childhood granulomatous periorificial dermatitis** CGPD is more common in boys than girls. Topical azelaic acid has been used successfully to treat CGPD. The disorder was first described in 1970 by Gianotti in a case series of five children. **Acne** Typical features of the condition include blackheads or whiteheads, pimples, oily skin, and possible scarring. directly to the affected skin, such as azelaic acid, benzoyl peroxide, and salicylic acid, are commonly used. The resulting appearance can lead to lack of confidence, anxiety, reduced self-esteem, and, in extreme cases, depression or

thoughts of suicide. == Medical uses == 21afcebdd1 One common adverse effect is an upset stomach. More significant side effects include stomach ulcers, stomach bleeding, and worsening asthma. Bleeding risk is greater among those who are older, drink alcohol, take other NSAIDs, or are on other blood thinners. Aspirin is not recommended in the last part of pregnancy. It is not generally recommended in children with viral infections because of the risk of Reye syndrome. High doses may result in ringing in the ears. 21afcebdd1 The chronic inflammatory condition that usually includes comedones, inflamed papules, and pustules (pimples) is called acne. Infection causes inflammation and the development of pus. Whether a skin condition classifies as acne depends on the number of comedones and infection. For pain or fever, effects typically begin within 30 minutes. Aspirin works similarly to other NSAIDs but also suppresses the normal functioning of platelets. 21afcebdd1 The most common adverse effects are dry lips (cheilitis), dry and fragile skin (xeroderma), dry eyes and an increased susceptibility to sunburn. Uncommon and rare side effects include muscle aches and pains (myalgias), headaches, and depression in some users. Some of those side effects can persist long after the discontinuation of the use of the drug. Isotretinoin may cause liver failure, therefore the patient's blood levels should be regularly tested. It is known to cause birth defects due to in-utero exposure because of the molecule's close resemblance... 21afcebdd1 Common side effects include itchiness and rash at the site of application, headache, and nausea. Long-term use may result in increased growth of fungi. Use during pregnancy and breastfeeding appears to be safe. Mupirocin is chemically a carboxylic acid. It works by blocking a bacterium's ability to make protein, which usually results in bacterial death. 21afcebdd1 == Early life and education == 21afcebdd1 Susceptibility to acne is primarily genetic in 80% of cases. The roles of diet and cigarette smoking in the condition are unclear, and neither cleanliness nor exposure to sunlight are associated with acne. In both sexes, hormones called androgens appear to be part of the underlying mechanism, by causing increased production of sebum. Another common factor is the excessive growth of the bacterium *Cutibacterium acnes*, which is present on the skin. 21afcebdd1 Treatments for acne are available, including lifestyle changes, medications, and medical procedures. The most effective medication is isotretinoin. Eating fewer simple carbohydrates such as sugar may minimize the condition.
