The former chancery building began in 1960 and was completed in 1964 at a cost of US\$5 million. At the time, it was the second largest United States embassy building in the world. The first U.S. Embassy to open in Mexico City was in January 1899 after the elevation of the American Legation. According to Mexico's National Institute of Statistics and Geography (INEGI), a locality is "any place settled with one or more dwellings, which may or may not be inhabited, and which is known by a name given by law or tradition". Urban localities are those with more than 2,500 residents, which can be designated as cities, villages or towns according to the laws of each state. The National Urban System, compiled by the National Population Council (CONAPO) in 2018, identifies 401 urban localities in Mexico with more than 15,000 residents as "cities". Most localities defined by INEGI are contained within a single municipality, although exceptions such as Naucalpan and Veracruz exist. After construction delays, the new Chancery was completed in November 2025 at a cost of approximately US\$943 million. It is currently the largest...
