At the physiological level, menopause happens because of a decrease in the ovaries' production of the hormones estrogen and progesterone. Additionally a decrease in hormone levels can have other sources, including some types of chemotherapy. Women often notice symptoms of hormonal changes prior. Natural menopause is the result of a decrease in the production of the hormones estrogen and progesterone. During the transition to menopause, menstrual Menopause is the time when menstrual periods permanently stop, marking the end of the reproductive stage for the female human. For women who have not undergone a hysterectomy, it is often suggested that they take progesterone in addition to an estrogen patch in order to protect the endometrium of the uterus. Transdermal estrogens are not recommended for all women; there are important precautions and side effects that should be considered before use.

Primary ovarian insufficiency (POI) can be seen as part of a continuum of changes leading to menopause that differ from age-appropriate menopause in the age of onset, degree of symptoms, and sporadic return to normal ovarian function. POI affects approximately 1 in 10,000 women under age 20, 1 in 1,000 women under age 30, and 1 in 100 of those under age 40
