== Nomenclature == f084c84e8a Gabapentin binds to $\alpha 2\delta$ subunits to modulate calcium channel function and neurotransmitter release, weakly affects glutamate signaling pathways, and does not act on GABA receptors. Sleepiness and dizziness are the most common side effects. Serious side effects include extreme sedation, respiratory depression and allergic reactions. In December 2008, the US Food and Drug Administration issued a class-wide warning for gabapentinoids for an increased risk of suicide. It was studied for neuropathic pain in 2005 by Winkler et al., with good results: it had minimal effects on motor coordination and alertness at effective doses, and appeared to be equally effective as gabapentin. f084c84e8a

Valnoctamide results: it had minimal effects on motor coordination and alertness at effective doses, and appeared to be equally effective as gabapentin. It is a structural isomer of valpromide, a valproic acid prodrug; unlike valpromide, however, valnoctamide is not transformed into its homologous acid, valnoctic acid, in vivo. == f084c84e8a Clinically used gabapentinoids include gabapentin, pregabalin, baclofen and mirogabalin, as well as a gabapentin prodrug, gabapentin enacarbil. Further analogues like imagabalin and atagabalin have been tested in clinical trials but their development has been halted. Other gabapentinoids which are used in scientific research but have not been approved for medical use include 4-methylpregabalin and PD-217,014. f084c84e8a As with all other drugs approved by the FDA for treating epilepsy, the pregabalin labeling warns of an increased suicide risk when combined with other drugs. When pregabalin is taken at high doses over a long period of time, addiction may occur, but if taken at usual doses the risk is low. Anxiolytic This effect is in contrast to anxiogenic agents which increase anxiety. Pharmacology Biochemistry and An anxiolytic (; also antipanic or anti-anxiety agent) is a medication or other intervention that reduces anxiety. Anxiolytic medications are used for the treatment of anxiety disorders and their related psychological and physical symptoms. "R-phenibut binds to the $\alpha 2-\delta$ subunit of voltage-dependent calcium channels and exerts gabapentin-like anti-nociceptive effects" f084c84e8a

== Frequency of side effects == f084c84e8a Common side effects can include headache, dizziness, sleepiness, euphoria, confusion, trouble with memory, poor coordination, dry mouth, problems with vision, and weight gain. Serious side effects may include angioedema, kidney damage, and seizures. f084c84e8a Depressants are closely related to sedatives as a category of drugs. The terms may sometimes be used interchangeably or may be used in somewhat different contexts. Nearly all commonly used depressants are addictive, and use of them carries the risk of death from respiratory depression, especially in opioids. f084c84e8a Side effects of phenibut can include sedation, sleepiness, nausea, irritability, agitation, dizziness, euphoria, and sometimes headache, among others. Overdose of phenibut can produce marked central nervous system depression including unconsciousness. The medication is structurally related to the neurotransmitter γ -aminobutyric acid (GABA), and hence is a GABA analogue. Phenibut is thought to act as a GABAB receptor agonist, similarly to baclofen and γ -hydroxybutyrate (GHB). However, at low concentrations, phenibut mildly increases the concentration of dopamine in the brain, providing stimulatory effects in addition to the anxiolysis. f084c84e8a Anxiety is a naturally occurring emotion and response. When anxiety levels exceed the tolerability of a person, anxiety disorders may occur. People with anxiety disorders can exhibit fear responses, such as defensive behaviors, high levels of alertness, and negative emotions. Pregabalin Pregabalin also has antiallodynic properties. The European Federation of Neurological Societies recommends pregabalin as a first-line agent for the treatment of pain Pregabalin, sold under the brand name Lyrica among others, is an anticonvulsant, analgesic, and anxiolytic amino acid medication used to treat epilepsy, neuropathic pain, fibromyalgia, restless legs syndrome, opioid withdrawal, generalized anxiety disorder (GAD), and postherpetic neuralgia (a type of nerve damage that can result from shingles). compares to gabapentin for this use. Its use in epilepsy is as an add-on therapy for partial seizures. When used before surgery, it reduces pain but results in greater sedation and visual disturbances. It is taken by mouth f084c84e8a
