New York State Route 367 Here, NY 367 serves Ashland Town Hall at the intersection of Main and 6th streets and the Wellsburg Village Centre on 5th New York State Route 367 (NY 367) is a state highway located entirely within the village of Wellsburg in Chemung County, New York, in the United States. NY 367 originally extended north to Lowman when it was assigned as part of the 1930 renumbering of state highways in New York. There is no corresponding signed state route on the Pennsylvania side of the border; instead, the road becomes State Route 4013 (SR 4013), one of Pennsylvania's unsigned quadrant routes. east-west streets are numbered. The route serves as the main street of Wellsburg in both function and name. It was truncated to its current length in 1949. 07 miles (1. 72 km) from the Pennsylvania state line south of the village center to an intersection with NY 427 just north of it. == Route description == From there to Pulaski Street, it is New York State Route 107 (NY 107). This segment includes the Glen Cove Arterial Highway (also known as part of Pratt Boulevard) - an expressway that was intended to connect to a proposed bridge across the Long Island Sound to Connecticut. The limited-access section of the road is ceremoniously named Sergeant Major Daniel Joseph Daly Memorial Highway, in honor of Glen Cove native Daniel Joseph Daly. The majority of Ridge Road and modern NY 104 from the village of Red Creek to the town of Mexico were originally designated as part of Route 30, an unsigned legislative route, early in the 20th century.
