It may also be called rebound or reflex hyperhidrosis. MiraDry It also reduces axillary hair by about 75%. miraDry is a microwave-based medical device developed by Miramar Labs which is used in the treatment of axillary hyperhidrosis. It is about 72. It was approved by the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in 2011 and was also approved in Europe. miraDry selectively destroys axillary sweat glands without affecting the superficial layers of the skin. It was approved by the US miraDry is a microwave-based medical device developed by Miramar Labs which is used in the treatment of axillary hyperhidrosis. In addition to sweat glands, miraDry destroys hair follicles in the axillary region regardless of hair color. 5 to 90% effective and sweat is reduced by about 82% on average. A case of death due to miraDry caused by necrotizing fasciitis that was complicated by streptococcal toxic shock syndrome has been reported. The effects of miraDry are noticeable almost immediately and are long-lasting or permanent aa6d0f6800
