Suppository There are three types of suppositories, each to insert into a different sections: rectal suppositories into the rectum, vaginal suppositories into the vagina, and urethral suppositories into the urethra of a male. The term unit dose can also refer to non-reusable packaging, particularly when each drug product is individually packaged. Typically, the drug is given this way to avoid being stopped by the blood-brain barrier, as it may not be able to pass into the brain when given orally. The epidural route is used by physicians and nurse anesthetists to administer local anesthetic agents, analgesics, diagnostic medicines such as radiocontrast agents, and other medicines such as glucocorticoids. The technique of intentional epidural administration of medication was first described in 1921 by the Spanish Aragonese military surgeon Fidel Pagés. surrounding the genitals or pelvic organs. Epidural administration involves the placement of a catheter into the epidural space, which may remain in place for the duration of the treatment 3ebdaf4b45
