Land permanent snow and glaciers. Land terrain varies greatly, consisting of mountains, deserts, plains. The remainder consists of desert, savannah, and prairie 308989a8cd

During interglacials, such as the present one, the climate warms and the tundra recedes polewards following the ice sheets. Forests return to areas that once supported tundra vegetation. Interglacials are identified on land or in shallow epicontinental seas by their paleontology. Floral and faunal remains of species pointing to temperate climate and indicating a specific age are used to identify particular interglacials. Commonly used are mammalian and molluscan species, pollen and plant macro-remains (seeds and fruits). However, many other fossil remains may be... 308989a8cd

The state is approximately 545 miles (877 km) east to west along the Canada-United States border and 320 miles (510 km) north to south. The state is a large geographical area (147,046 square miles (380,850 km²)) that is split by the Continental Divide, resulting in watersheds draining into the Pacific Ocean, Gulf of Mexico and Hudson's Bay. The fourth largest state in land area, it has been divided up in official and unofficial ways into a variety of regions. Olympic Coast National Marine Sanctuary Extending 25 to 40 miles (22 to 35 nmi; 40 to 64 km) from the shore, it includes most of the continental shelf, as well as parts of three important submarine canyons, the Nitinat Canyon, the Quinault Canyon, and the Juan de Fuca Canyon. Sanctuary stewardship is also shared with the Hoh, Quileute, and Makah Tribes, as well as the Quinault Indian Nation. Designated on May 11, 1994, the sanctuary encompasses 3,189 square miles (2,408 sq nmi; 8,259 km²) of the Pacific Ocean along the Olympic Peninsula of Washington state, from Cape Flattery in the north to the mouth of the Copalis River, a distance of about 162.
