The soy protein isolate was produced in a small pilot plant and sold for use in Chili con carne, but the product was not commercially successful. Membrane proteins are common, and medically important—about a third of all human proteins are membrane proteins, and these are targets for more than half of all drugs. Soybeans also contain biologically active or metabolic proteins, such as enzymes, trypsin inhibitors, hemagglutinins, and cysteine proteases similar to papain.
