Maharaja Sutasansu Kumar Acharya Bahadur of Mymensingh established an orchard in Kansat, Chapainawabganj, where Khirsapat mangoes were cultivated along with other varieties. Currently, this variety is commercially cultivated in five upazilas of Chapainawabganj district. Mulberry == History == The USDA collection was originally believed to have over 500 varieties of mango germplasm, but genetic testing showed several duplicates. In the United States, South Florida is one of the centers for mangoes due to year-round temperate climate and culture fascinated by mangoes and several nurseries dedicated to bringing new varieties of mangoes into the US by either import or selective breeding. Jujube Pawpaw, both the tropical *Carica papaya* and the North American *Asimina triloba* Dasher mango was originated in the Lucknow district of Uttar Pradesh. The first plant of Dasher mango, today known as "Mother Dasehri Tree", originated in the Dasehri village, Block Kakori Dist. Lucknow in the Orchard of Nawab Syed Anser Zaidi Sahab. The Mother Dasehri is still in the possession of Nawab Anser's family. This tree is approximately 185 years old and still bears fruits. Most commercial cultivars belong to *Mangifera indica*, while a few commercial varieties grown in Southeast Asia belong to other *Mangifera* species. Southeast Asia, India, Australia, the United States and some African countries cultivate locally selected varieties, while most other countries grow cultivars developed in Florida. Depending on the cultivar, mango fruits vary in size, shape, sweetness, skin colour, and flesh colour, which may be pale yellow, gold, green, or orange. Fruit tree forms Shaping and promoting a particular tree form is undertaken to establish the plant in a particular situation under certain environmental conditions, to increase fruit yield, and to enhance fruit quality. For example, pruning a tree to a pyramid shape enables trees to be planted closer together. particular tree form is undertaken to establish the plant in a particular situation under certain environmental conditions, to increase fruit yield, and to enhance Fruit trees are grown in a variety of shapes, sometimes for aesthetic appeal but mainly to encourage fruit production. The form or shape of fruit trees can be manipulated by pruning and training. An open bowl or cup form helps sunlight penetrate the canopy, thus encouraging a high fruit yield whilst keeping the tree short and accessible for harvesting. Other shapes such as cordons, espaliers and fans provide opportunities for growing trees two dimensionally against walls or fences, or they can be trained to function as barriers 5fea20ab19
