It was originally believed to be another strain of Tomato spotted wilt virus, but genetic investigations revealed them to be separate viruses. The INSV

virus infects by injecting the RNA the virus contains into the cell which then starts using the cell resources to transcribe what the virus RNA states. It is largely spread by the insect vector of the western flower thrips. The disease is mainly controlled by the elimination of the western flower thrip vector and by destroying any infected plant material. As the name implies, the main symptom on plants is necrotic spots that appear on the leaves. will start the cycle over again. It is a negative-strand RNA virus which has a tripartite genome. The virus infects more than 648 species of plants including important horticultural and agricultural species such as fuchsia, tomato, orchids, and lettuce (especially romaine). Typically the best way to manage a virus problem is to get rid of any vectors that may carry the disease 572747c317

Typically, they are plants that grow aggressively, multiply quickly without natural controls (such as native herbivores or soil chemistry), and cause adverse effects upon contact or ingestion. over the soil.
