Oral irrigators have also been used An oral irrigator (also called a dental water jet, water flosser or, by the brand name of the best-known such device, Waterpik) is a home dental care device which uses a stream of high-pressure pulsating water intended to remove dental plaque and food debris between teeth and below the gum line. The devices may also provide easier cleaning for braces and dental implants. Regular use of an oral irrigator is believed to improve gingival health. A 2019 meta-analysis found that water-jet irrigation is more effective at reducing bleeding on probing than flossing 7b87771807

Dental plaque It has been observed that differences in the composition of dental plaque microbiota exist between men and women, particularly in the presence of periodontitis. Dental plaque is also known as microbial plaque, oral biofilm, dental biofilm, dental plaque biofilm, and bacterial plaque biofilm. Bacterial plaque is one of the major causes for dental decay and gum disease. It is commonly found between the teeth, on the front of teeth, behind teeth, on chewing surfaces, along the gumline (supragingival), or below the gumline cervical margins (subgingival). It is a sticky colorless deposit at first, but when it forms tartar, it is often brown or pale yellow. Gingivitis Dental plaque is a biofilm of microorganisms (mostly bacteria, but also fungi) that grows on surfaces within the mouth. This is characterized by the cardinal signs of inflammation including a red, puffy appearance of the gums and bleeding due to brushing or flossing 7b87771807

General guidelines for adults suggest brushing at least twice a day with a fluoridated toothpaste: brushing before going to sleep at night and after breakfast in the morning. Cleaning between the teeth is called interdental cleaning and is as important as tooth brushing. This is because a toothbrush cannot reach between the teeth and therefore only removes about 50% of plaque from the surface of the teeth.
