In the fiscal year 2019–20, the total hydroelectric power generated in India was 156 TWh (excluding small hydro) with an average capacity factor of 38. 3% of its total utility power generation capacity. India's hydroelectric power potential is estimated at 148,700 MW at 60% load factor. Additional smaller hydroelectric power units with a total capacity of 4,683 MW (1. 3% of its total utility power generation capacity) have been installed. As of 31 March 2020, India's installed utility-scale hydroelectric capacity was 46,000 MW, or 12. 71% b1bc613484

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
